VENUE

The meeting will be held in the International Centre for Circulatory Health (ICCH), 59 North Wharf Road, Paddington, London, W2 1LA.

- By Tube: ICCH is an eight minute walk from Paddington Underground Station (Bakerloo, Circle, District and Hammersmith and City Lines)
- By Bus: The following buses stop in Praed Street (10 minute walk to ICCH): Nos 7, 15, 23, 27, 36, and the No. 18 stops in North Wharf Road
- By Rail: Paddington Mainline Station is a six minute walk from ICCH
- By Car: On site parking is very limited around the St. Mary's Hospital site and delegates are strongly advised to come by public transport.
